

Book Club Discussion Guide for South Beach Love

- 1. *South Beach Love* features two *quinceañeras*. Are you familiar with *quinceañearas*? What are some traditions in your own families that might be similar?
- 2. What did you like about Sara's character? How do you think she changed throughout the story?
- 3. What did you like about Tony's character? How do you think he changed throughout the story?
- 4. Both Sara and Tony need the publicity that the article could provide for their respective careers. Have you ever experienced a similar situation where you were competing against one of your friends, family, or loved ones? How did you resolve it?
- 5. One source of the conflict between Sara and Tony is Roberta Lane, the journalist who pits them against each other initially. How do you feel about her?
- 6. South Beach Love includes many delectable and delicious descriptions of Cuban dishes that both Sara and Tony prepare. What were some of your favorite dishes that you'd like to replicate?
- 7. Samantha and Angelica, the fifteen-year-old girls, are considered rivals on the soccer field and during their *quinceañera* preparations. What did you think of their relationship?
- 8. What was your favorite part of *South Beach Love*? Why?
- 9. When Tony and Sara finally kiss (spoiler alert!), how did you react? What makes them perfect for each other?
